Her sports of choice now are Mondioring and Agility. Cindy was also a professional dog groomer for 15 years, and has raised and trained dogs of many different breeds. This experience has given Cindy a wealth of information on training and managing dogs of all breeds. The Principles of Dog Training

When Ed Frawley purchased his first video camera in 1978, the last thing on his mind was, "Someday I will teach people how to train dogs using a computer." Four years later, Ed produced his first dog training video titled, "Training the Competition Obedience Dog." It quickly became evident that it was impossible to teach everything there is to know about competition obedience in the amount of time you could squeeze into a single VHS tape.

With the advent of the internet came streaming video. Streaming video has opened another door to the world of dog training. It gives us the tools to instantly provide the amount of information that is necessary to teach complex skills. With streaming video, we are no longer limited by how much information we can fit into a DVD. We learned that many people did not have the attention span to watch a 4 hour DVD, but they do have the attention span to watch a two to five minute video on one specific subject.

Enter online training. Leerburg's very talented IT staff spent 2 ½ years developing an online training platform tailored specifically to teach people how to train dogs. Leerburg Online University allows us to organize a series of short streaming videos, text, audio, PDFs, and other visual materials in a systematic step by-step training process. You can now watch a short video of an instructor explaining an exercise along with instructor and student demonstrations of that exercise. Through our smart phone video uploads, you will have a chance to demonstrate the skills you have learned with your own dog and receive instructor feedback to help hone those skills.

Our goal from the beginning has been to put a hands-on, interactive approach to online dog training. Our system allows you to decide what learning modality best fits you and your schedule. Students have the benefit of watching videos, reading the material, and

listening to podcasts. Students have the ability to review the material and post any questions that may come up through the discussion forum or a private message. In addition to the weekly discussions and messaging, we offer live chats where students can log on and talk directly to their instructors. 



Cindy Puck and her husband, Michael were working as volunteers at their local shelter in Tennessee when they found out about Rose, an abandoned Pit Bull that was due to have puppies. Rose was found in very bad shape and was taken into the local animal shelter along with an injured male pit bull who is the father of the puppies. It was assumed they were in a fight or used for fighting based on the injuries they came in with. The shelter could not house her not knowing when her pups were due, so they were looking at euthanization.

Cindy and Michael were able to rescue Rose, saving both her and her unborn puppies. She was with them for two weeks before she delivered 3 healthy baby boys on January 21, 2016. All 3 puppies were taken in by a rescue agency when they were 7 weeks old, and after a screening and background check and multi step process the agency uses to place their pups in homes to ensure they are going to be well taken care of, not used for breeding, and especially not used for fighting, all 3 pups have found homes.

Cindy and Michael officially adopted Rose. She is now spayed and in very good health. She is also very happy and has made a wonderful new family member.

Unfortunately, Pit Bull fighting and other animal abuse is still taking place all around the country. Please be aware of how important it is to report any known activity, to have all pets spayed and neutered, and to get laws passed that would enforce severe penalties for dog fighting and any type of abuse across the US. If we all work together, we can end animal abuse.

How to Fit a Prong Collar

The biggest problem with prong collars is that new dog owners don't know how to put them on, how to size them or how to have their dog wear them. This article will address these issues.

Prong collars are ordered by size (small, medium, large or extra large). They come in a standard length, which is adjusted to fit the neck of the dog by removing or adding links to the collar.

Prong collars are meant to be put on and taken off before and after daily training sessions. Unlike a choke collar that is often left on the dog all the time (in some cases this can be a dangerous practice).

A common problem new trainers have is they don't remove enough links to get the correct snug fit. When that happens the collar hangs down on the dogs neck which results in the collar not working the way that it was designed.



After 50 years of training dogs, over 30 as a professional dog trainer there are a few sayings that make a lot of sense to me:

"Dogs don't know how to be good unless we show them."

"You create your dogs value system."

"You can feed, water, and love your dog and he will like you, but he very well may not respect you."

"Dogs know what you know and they know what you don't know."

This article details how I establish pack structure with an adult dog. This is especially important with dogs that are predisposed to becoming dominant or aggressive.

The information you are about to read is the way we introduce new dogs in our home here at Leerburg. It also explains the way I have gained control over some very tough and dangerous dominant dogs that I have owned over the past 45 plus years of breeding, owning, and training police service dogs.

Becoming a pack leader involves adopting the attitude of a pack leader. It does not involve aggression towards a dog, it doesn't involve rolling him on his back, hard leash corrections, or even raising your voice to the dog. It involves adopting a leader's attitude. This is something that new dog owners must learn how to do.

Every dog knows a leader when he is in the presence of one. They can sense a leader. They don't need leash corrections to consider their owner a pack leader. In fact inappropriate corrections often result in a dog looking at the offender with contempt rather than respect.

There is an old saying; "Dogs know what you know, and they know what you don't know." This article is going to explain how I show my dog "what I know." It is also going to explain how I establish responsibility and limits to the relationship I build with my dogs.

Love is Not Enough

The vast majority of behavioral problems are caused by mistakes that were made in the basic foundation of how relationships were set up between owners and their dogs.
